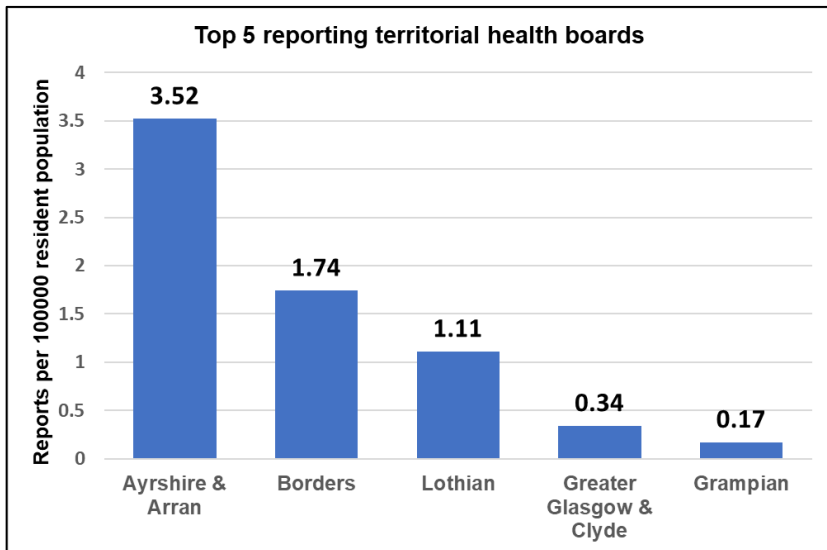

IRIC has been working with colleagues across the UK to develop a common dataset for medical device incident reporting. In Scotland the work is supported by Healthcare Improvement Scotland and Datix Scottish User Group. IRIC are one of the first organisations in the UK to adopt the common dataset which will improve the sharing of incident data with MHRA and manufactures.
