


Innovative AI/LLM Tool Research to Enhance EFM Team Collaboration – Your Views Needed Now

NHS Estates and Facilities Management (EFM) colleagues at all levels are invited to contribute to an important research project led by Carl-Magnus von Behr and Carl Partow at the University of Cambridge in collaboration with IHEEM. The research project is centred on developing innex.ai, an Al/LLM tool to boost productivity for NHS EFM staff.

The tool is developed from three years of research on knowledge sharing among NHS Trusts and in partnership with AI specialists at the University of Cambridge. It unifies repositories spanning NHS guidance and best practices and leverages AI technology for fast and reliable access to the latest information. Moreover, it will facilitate connecting to domain experts and peers for best-practice knowledge sharing and assist in policy drafting and grant applications. A recent pilot workshop at the HefmA Trent Branch annual conference has already demonstrated promising results, indicating significant productivity improvements.
