Is this course for you?

You should be working in a position with responsibility for maintaining safe building water systems and have attended the Eastwood Park 'Legionella responsible person' or an equivalent course in the last three years. The course builds upon previous training experience and updates you with recent changes in the field and current case studies. Therefore prior knowledge and training is essential.

How often should I complete this refresher training?

We suggest that refresher training for Responsible Persons (Water) is undertaken every 3 years.
