



- LST Projects was tasked with relocating the Child Development Centre (CDC) from overcrowded spaces in the Green Wing to a newly designed area in the Yellow Wing
- The project involved demolishing the existing second-floor layout. New room layouts were built to meet acoustic standards, including a specialised audiology suite with a "box in box" design
- Additional features included new sliding and folding doors between the gym and therapy areas, the installation of three hoists, and an acoustic sliding door
- A new reception and waiting area was created for a welcoming environment, featuring a sculptural tree and built-in seating for young visitors, ensuring easy access and passive surveillance for all
