“A step-change in Scottish Healthcare delivery”

Situated by the iconic Clydebank crane, the Clydebank Health Centre is improving primary care services in the area and forming the central base for community health teams.

Residents can access GP practices, podiatry and physiotherapy services plus consulting and treatment rooms.

The new facility is described as forming a ‘centre point’ within the Queen’s Quay regeneration area.

Hygenius provided a full group 1 and 2 FF&E package for the consulting rooms, treatment rooms, dirty utilities, clean utilities, storage rooms, offices and staff areas. We also provided bespoke GP reception desks and tea points, including a low-height one for children!

The art on the centre’s main reception desk was designed in Glasgow and produced by Hygenius craftsmen who worked with the solid resin surfacing to embed images of the surrounding natural environment of Clydebank. Natural forms such as the shape and texture of the hills, river, lochs and the Cochno stones are at the centre of the design.
