Engineering Technician

Engineering Technicians apply proven techniques and procedures to the solution of practical engineering problems.

Engineering Technicians are required to apply safe systems of work and are able to demonstrate:

- *Evidence of their contribution to either the design, development, manufacture, commissioning, decommissioning, operation or maintenance of products, equipment, processes or services*
- *Supervisory or technical responsibility*
- *Effective interpersonal skills in communicating technical matters*
- *Commitment to professional engineering values.*

In this pack you will find information designed to help you in achieving Engineering Technician status.

It contains:

- A general guide to registration
- A copy of UK-SPEC, which sets out on pages 10-13 the competency standards you need to meet in order to be registered as an Engineering Technician
- A proforma which should be completed by you, with detail of your own work, stating how you meet the required competencies. You should record your evidence in the right-hand column, having made reference to both the Engineering Council Generic Standards and the Generic Guidance.
- A note of the fees involved

Once you have completed the proforma, please return it to this office for peer review by members of the IHEEM Membership & Registration Committee. If satisfactory, registration will follow. An interview is not usually required.
