Fast-track project at Freeman's hospital helps tackle NHS waiting lists

The new facility at Freeman's Hospital was transformed from car park to Day Treatment Centre in under 38 weeks.

Acting as a 'self-contained' resource, it won't be impacted by emergency admissions and procedures or winter pressures within the trust. As well as helping to tackle waiting list challenges created by the Covid19 pandemic, it will also minimise the amount of time patients need to stay in hospital, enabling them to recover in the comfort of their own home.
